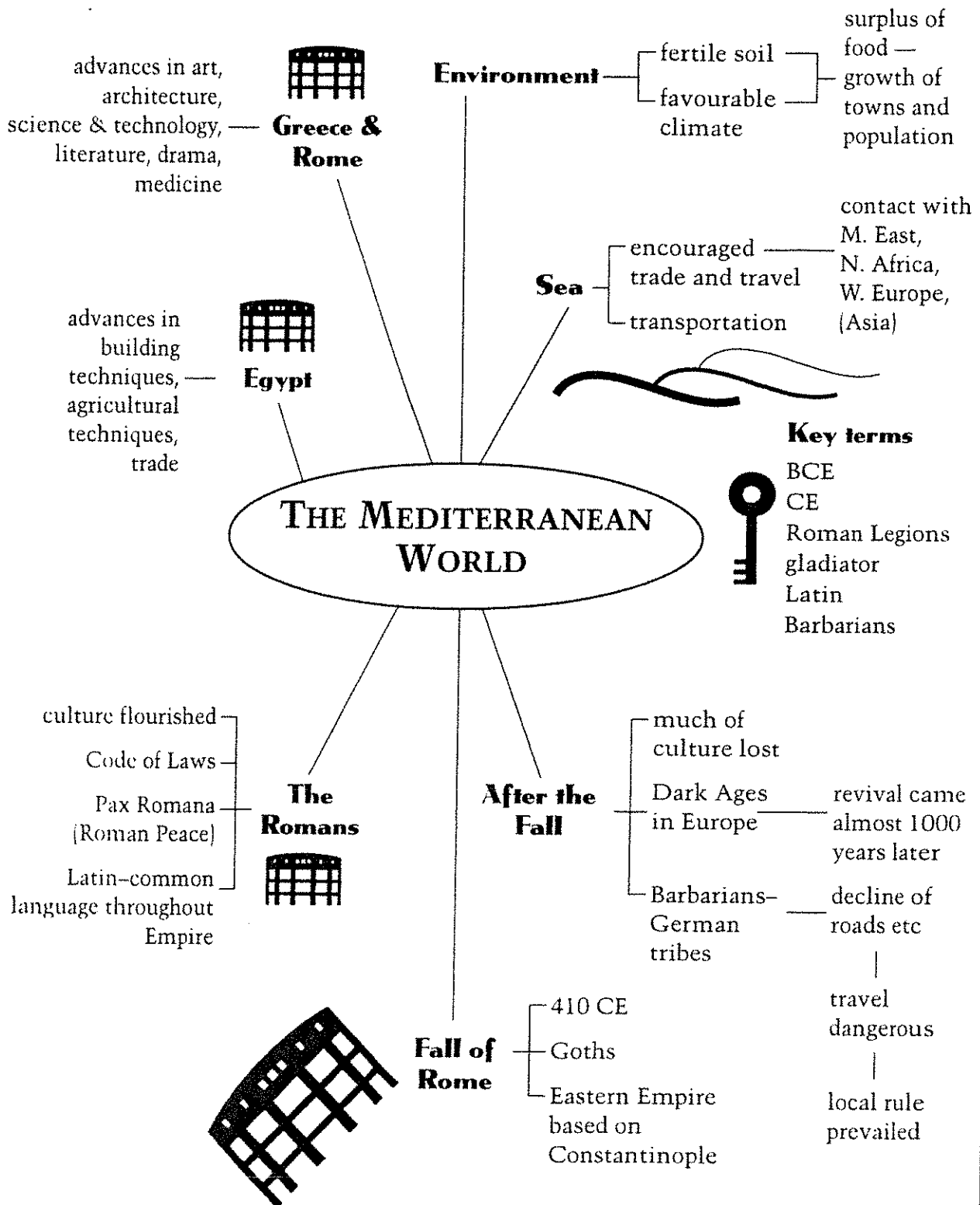

Conclusions

Similarities: monotheism, origins in Middle East, Abraham common to all three, Jerusalem is holy

city, all have faced persecution

Differences: conflicting claims over territory (e.g., Crusades in early time, Palestine/Israel today),

and over religious shrines (e.g., Jerusalem, Dome of the Rock)
