What is a Personal Write?

***Meaning** - comes from thoughts, feelings, opinions, memories, and reflections*

***Style** - demonstrates clarity and some variety in language*

***Form** - begins with a clear introduction and follows a logical sequence through to a conclusion*

- because this writing is not revised or edited, some of the connections and transitions may be awkward

***Conventions** - follows standard conventions for basic spelling, punctuation, grammar, and sentence structure; has been proofread*

**Try to address the 5 W's (who, what, where, when, and why) + 1 H (how) and be descriptive!*
